

BOW STREET



DESIGNER: Sarah Palmer

A layout made from scraps of paper – will work with any colour as long as one palette all red, all blue, all green, etc is used.



TIME NEEDED TO COMPLETE CLASS: 1 hour

PROFIT ON COMPLETION: £150 for using PAINT
£100 for NOT using Paint



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Supplies Needed:

Kraft cardstock · Alpha Stickers (Different sizes & Manufacturers) · Orange ribbon 1" thick & 8" long · Lace Trim 1" thick & 5 ½ inches long · Butterfly punch (Martha Stewart) · Jenni Bowlin Mini "Lucky" brown bingo card · Jenni Bowlin brown border stickers · Jenni Bowlin black "apothecary" stickers · October Afternoon "Farm Fresh" word stickers · Sassafras Lass Vintage Yummy "Remember Me" Paper · 4 strips/scraps of orange patterned paper (different sizes & manufacturers) shortest strip 5 3/4 " & longest 7 ¼" · Green AC "Rockabye" thickers numbers 1 & O · small piece of decorative border sticker (ribbon will do as a substitute)

Tools to include cream paint, paintbrush, trimmer, scissors, edge distresser, stapler, glue & foam pads

Photo Portrait Size 3 x 4 ½" with white border around of people you love

Instructions:

1. Cut Kraft cardstock to 8 ½" by 11" or leave it 12"x12"
2. Cut strips of orange patterned paper into different lengths – the shortest being 5 ¾" and the longest being 7 ¼". Make them different widths too, smallest being 1". (Fig 1)
3. Distress the edges of the 3 longest strips and make a freehand scalloped edge along one of the longest sides on the shortest strip. Position strips on the LHS of the kraft cardstock.
4. With the Jenni Bowlin border sticker, take the scallop one and cut a piece so it goes behind your freehand scallop strip and overlaps the longest strip. (Fig 2)
5. Take the Jenni Bowlin "Apothecary" sheet and cut a piece of the ruler border sticker and place on the top strip at the right hand side. (Fig 2)
6. Cut a strip of the decorative border and adhere it underneath the 2nd strip on the left hand side (Fig 2)
7. Once happy with the placement of these strips and stickers, adhere the grouping to the kraft cardstock. Use foam pads to adhere the last (shortest) strip to the kraft cardstock.



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8. Take the Jenni Bowlin bingo card and place it on the left hand side on top of the 1st strip, angling it slightly. (Fig 3)

9. On top of the bingo card, adhere the “favorites” tab sticker from the October Afternoon sticker sheet, making sure it covers the “L” & “U” on the bingo card slightly.

10. Wrap the lace trim around the photo near the bottom and adhere the into place, cut the excess trim off the back.

11. Make a big bow using the orange ribbon and cut off excess. Once happy with the size of bow, adhere it in the middle of the lace . (Fig 4)

12. Place your photo at a slight angle on top of the bingo card but DO NOT STICK DOWN!

13. When happy with the position, mark on the kraft cardstock and take photo back off of the layout.

14. Get the alpha stickers and make the title, mixing up the fonts will give it an interesting look.

15. Once happy with the title, paint over it using the cream paint, being careful not to get paint over the patterned paper strips. Spread thinly – to dry quickly. (Fig 5)

16. When the paint is dry, carefully lift off the alpha stickers. You can go around the outline of the letters if you wish, I chose to leave as it was.

17. Adhere photo to kraft cardstock in the position you marked previously. Add a couple of staples to the left hand side of the photo.

18. Take the “My Bliss” sticker from the October Afternoon sheet and adhere using a foam pad just above the bingo card.

19. Cut 2 frames out from the Sassafras Lass “Remember Me” paper, stick the first one down straight onto strips of paper and using a foam pad, adhere the second one overlapping the first frame slightly.



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20. Take the Thicker digits and place inside the second frame and stick the tiny alpha “x” to the left of it.
21. Adhere the Jenni Bowlin “Know This” sticker underneath the second frame a little bit at the top.
22. Finish by punching out a butterfly, made using the kraft cardstock and adhere it to the kraft cardstock.
