# PALL MALL

## ***Supplies Needed:***

**Angel Crafts Kit** · 1x Heart Wreath from Tando Creative · 3x paper from Crate Paper - Pink Plum collection · 1 x kaiser rhinestones in pale pink and 1 in silver · 1/2 pack pink Fairytale Roses · 1/2 pack white Cameo Roses or Fairytale Roses · 1m pink sheer ribbon · 1m white sheer ribbon · pink with white spot ribbon - 13" · thin pale pink with white spot ribbon- 13" · 2-tone pink ribbon - 20" · pink heart cut ribbon - 10" · 4x white lace daisies · pink saddle stitch ribbon - 10"

**Tools:** sharp craft knife · scissors · craft mat · double sided tape · file · ink pads (brown & pink) · glossy accents

**Photos:** wreath uses no photos.

## ***Instructions:***

1. From Raspberry paper – Crate Paper - cut out all 3 butterflies carefully .Also at top left hand side, cut the large pink flower including leaves, cream flower and red flower. Also cut out 2 other smaller pink flowers – set all these to one side. Leave a small area of white around flowers
2. Also cut 7.5" x 9" from Peach paper and 4" x 7" from Pink Cherry and set to one side.
3. Decide how you would like to layout the wreath, hearts and crosses and take a photo as this will help you to remember.
4. Decide which paper you want to use to cover the large heart, I have used the pink side of Pink Cherry.
5. Cover the front of your heart with Double Sided Tape and then stick to the back of the paper – now use the Craft knife to trim around the heart. You may need to file around to create a smooth edge.
6. Now do this with all hearts and crosses, using all the papers, front and back.
7. After you have smoothed all the edges with your file, ink them all – I have used a pink, light and dark brown inks.
8. Remember to punch a hole through the large heart for ribbon to go through
9. Now place small hearts and crosses onto large heart – make sure you are happy with positioning. Then glue the pieces in place, using glossy accents. Use 1m of pink sheer to hang wreath.
12. Use some of the smaller pieces of ribbon to tie round the wreath, add white daisies and roses – keep 4 set aside. Add pink and silver bling.

\*A LO can be made with the pieces that were cut at the start – just utilize 1x 12x12 dark brown Bazzill & some lace.
